Emergency Preparedness Week: May 4 to 10, 2014

During Emergency Preparedness Week, held May 4 to 10, the City of Ottawa, through its Are You Ready program, is encouraging residents to build a more resilient Ottawa by taking the time to prepare themselves, their family and their neighbours for emergencies and disasters.

Spring Tree Planting

Forestry Services' spring planting program began the week of April 28th and will run until the end of June. This includes tree planting in parks, at City facilities, and along streets. Note that this information is what is planned, and cancellations/changes typically occur.

Buxton Crescent, Crowsnest Avenue, Farmington Avenue, Fielding Drive, Garwood Avenue, Hartman Crescent, Otterson Drive, Southmore Drive West, and Walkley Roadd are all scheduled for planting this spring.

Where a tree planting is scheduled on City property adjacent to a residence, individual notifications will be provided to the resident in advance of planting. Residents should also expect to see utility locate flags and paint on the ground prior to planting.

Safer Roads Ottawa Program

May 2014 Initiatives

The City of Ottawa and the Ottawa Police Service's Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) will focus on **motorcycle safety and unsafe vehicles and heavy trucks** for the month of May as part of the Safer Roads Program.

Motorcycle Safety

Between 2008 and 2012, there were 776 collisions involving motorcycles resulting in 517 injuries and 13 fatalities.

Unsafe vehicles and heavy trucks

Between 2008 and 2012, 707 reportable collisions on Ottawa roadways involved unsafe vehicles resulting in 213 injuries; 13 serious injuries and six fatalities. Causes of these collisions included defective brakes, steering, tires, lights, engine controls, trailer hitches, suspension, as well as obscured vision.

The Safer Roads Ottawa Program is a leading community partnership between Ottawa Fire Services, Ottawa Paramedic Service, Ottawa Police Service, Ottawa Public Health and the Public Works Department committed to preventing or eliminating road deaths and serious injuries for all people in the City of Ottawa, through culture change, community engagement, and development of a sustainable safe transportation environment.

Also participating in the Safer Roads Ottawa Program are the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), Sureté du Québec, Department of National Defence's Military Police and Gatineau Police Service to improve road safety for all residents of the national capital region.
