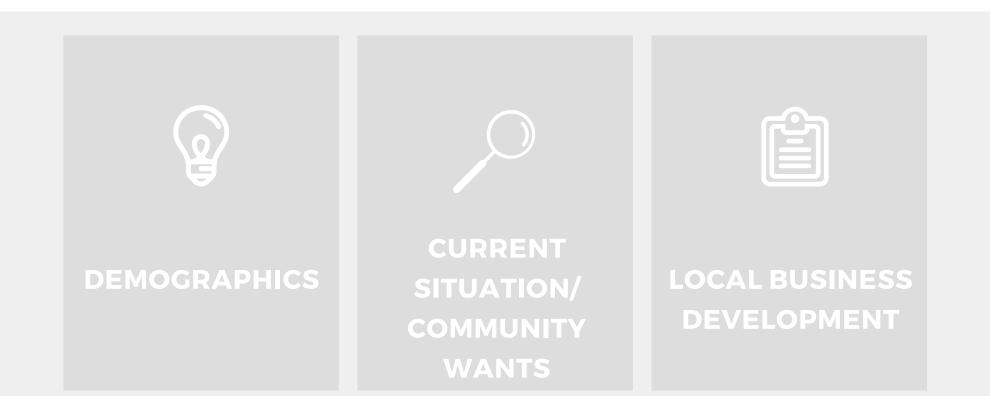

Aspects of a Strong Survey

INCREASED LIKEIHOOD OF RESPONSES



- Use an online survey platform
 - Increased ease, flexibility, and convenience
- Include an incentive
 - Consider offering a prize, discount or gift for completing the survey (Ex. entrance into raffle for 1/5 \$50 gift cards)
 - Encourages and motivates responses
- Follow-Up
 - Include contact information, and newsletter sign-up for survey results and data usage
 - Engages respondents in the mission of the survey

Survey Platforms

SURVEY MONKEY

- World's leading survey platform
- Easy to use and visually appealing
- Provides survey link for easy distribution
- Collects and calculates responses
- \$34/month for unlimited questions or \$119/month for multilingual feature



Best free option is Google Forms

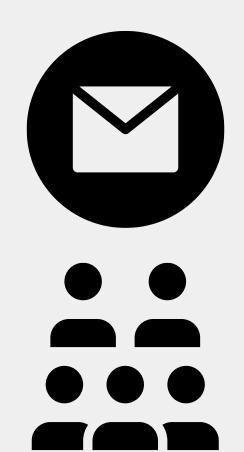


- E-mail Survey Link
- Physical Flyer with QR Code
- Physical Paper copy of survey (if needed)



E-MAIL SURVEY LINK

- Mass email survey link to Riverside Park Residents
- Post Survey link in online community groups (ex. Facebook group)
- Incentivize residents with a prize opportunity
 - ex. Complete the survey for a chance to win a \$50 gift card

Step 2: Create a QR code for the flyer with the survey link URL at https://www.qr-code-generator.com/

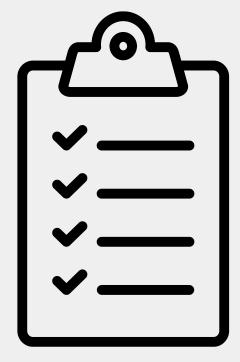
Step 3: Distribute flyer to Riverside Park residents





PHYSICAL PAPER COPY

- On the physical flyer provide an email or phone number to contact
- Residents who might not have access to technology can reach out for a physical copy of the survey or provide their answers over the phone
- A member of Mooney's Bay Ventures Inc. can insert the answers into SurveyMonkey







Additional Recommendations FOCUS GROUP

Pros

- Produces open discussion
- Allows further clarification
- Uncovers points and ideas not brought up on a survey

Cons

- Smaller numbers, resulting in less accuracy
- Participants may not speak their mind freely
 - There is no anonymity
