Yard Share Program

How to participate?

- ✓ Do you have a back, front or side yard that receives 8+ hrs of sunlight?
- ✓ Can that area be converted to garden plots (at no expense to you?)
- ✓ Will you share your yard with neighbours who will use those garden plots to grow food?

Email the RPCA Garden Committee at garden@riversidepark.ca and we will arrange a visit and discuss the options.

Once you are accepted into the Yard Share program, the RPCA will convert the area agreed upon into separate garden plots and will find neighbours who need garden space (because they do not have a yard). You will be compensated for water usage.

We would love to expand our program in 2025 to find 3 more yards and help at least 10 more families grow organic food.
