- The developer is completing further studies.



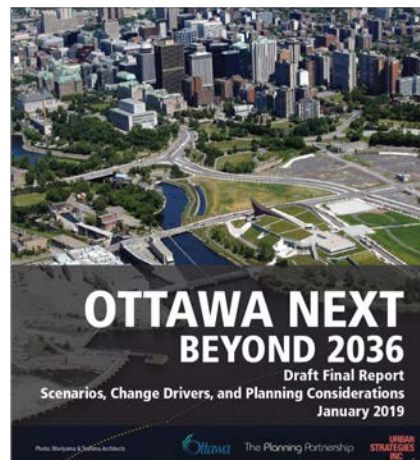

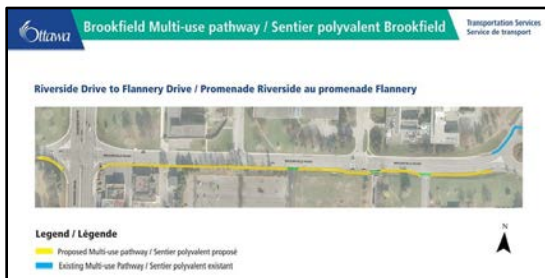

“Distraction Thefts”

- Ottawa Police Service is investigating several instances of “Distraction Thefts” that have occurred throughout the city in late-February and early-March.
- Victims are approached in public areas, parking lots.
- Assistance is typically offered (e.g., carrying purchases, pointing out dropped change).
- Suspects steal debit/credit cards while victim is distracted.
- Suspects are primarily (but not exclusively) targeting seniors.
- Residents are reminded to remain vigilant and be mindful of surroundings.
