



R4 Phase 2 Zoning Review for Residential Communities Within the Greenbelt

- Proposed zoning changes would apply to all residential neighbourhoods within the Greenbelt zoned R1 to R4 – includes Riverside Park.
- Consideration by City Planning Committee postponed to September 10.
