### **Fielding/Southmore Intersection**

- For over a year, Fielding Dr residents have been lobbying the city for a 3-way stop at the intersection of Fielding and Southmore, at the entrance of the South Cow Tunnel.
- In response, the city installed a traffic calming flex stick and signage last November, but has now agreed to install a stop sign for Southmore traffic.
- However, the primary concern for residents –
  especially parents of children is the speed of
  motorists travelling the length of Fielding, and only
  a full 3-way stop can address the safety needs for
  children, pedestrians, and cyclists.
- Councillor Brockington has supported residents throughout the process and will be assisting as they bring the matter before the city's Transportation Committee.


